

## Your inquiry about entry in the ECHA SCIP-Database for Endress+Hauser products

## Dear valued customer

With the amending of Directive 2008/98/EC on waste to (EU) 2018/851, manufacturers must provide information on SvHC (Substances of very High Concern) in their products together with other information also to ECHA via the central database SCIP (Substances of Concern In articles as such or in complex objects (Products)).

As this requirement applies to all manufacturers and sales organizations that supply products to the EU, it also applies to Endress+Hauser.

Due to the large volume and also the complexity of the information to be supplied a considerable amount of work is involved. For this reason, we will only have our products fully mapped in the SCIP database in the first few months of 2021.

Endress+Hauser undertakes to comply with its legal obligations.
